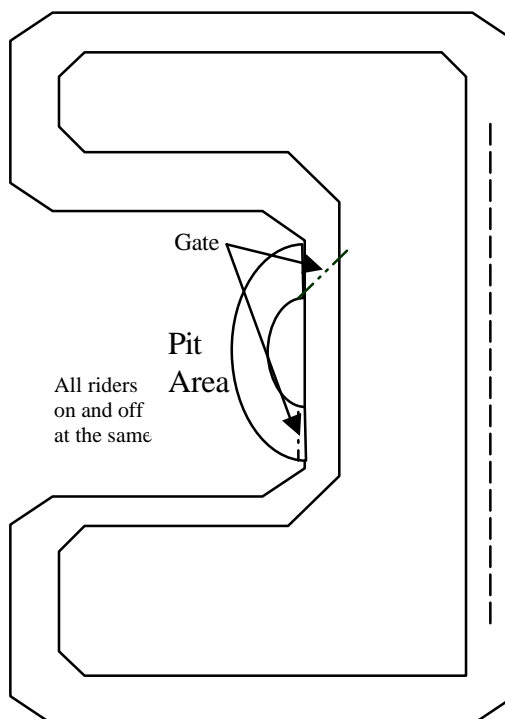

Ages 7- adult track

- 8' wide
- About 400 linear ft. for up to 6 karts
- Some type of divider to indicate lanes
- Pit area where all riders get on and off at the same time
- THEME THE TRACK in accordance with the rest of your operation
- Keep the track as flat and level as possible
- Track base can be any hard packed surface (ie. paved, crushed stone, crushed asphalt) Dirt will work but the track will become muddy when it rains or dusty when dry.

Ages 2-7 area

- The area can be a track but the target age range seems to like a confined open area to “pretend” to drive a car rather than race around a track.
- The area can be inside the main track to conserve space. A bridge/observation deck is best to allow access to this area so no one is walking across the main track.
- With this age group, it’s not about racing, it is about pretending to drive like mom & dad do. Have parking spaces, gas pumps, pretend store, etc.

Options

- Overhead start/finish sign
- Racing pennant flags
- Bridge (dig out under the bridge so it is flat for riders)
- Tires, hay bales or railing to keep riders on the track
- Light the track for night riding
